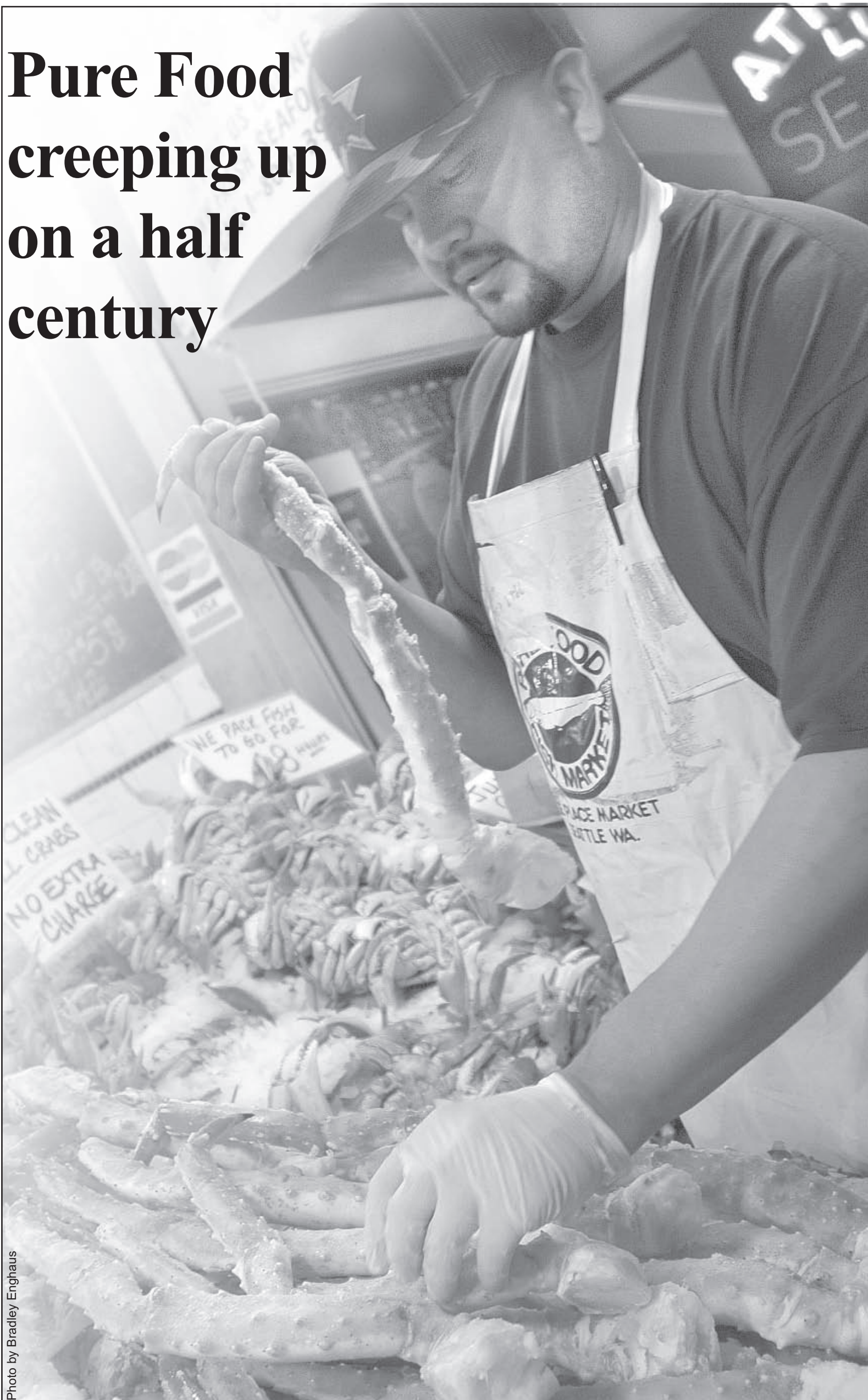

Information Booth Between First and Pike and the Market Clock under the awning. Also sells discount show tickets.

**ATM MACHINES** Six Market locations- end of Information Booth; inside of South Arcade by Pike Place Brewery; north end of Market inside hall by Emmett Watson's and the Souk; Down Under on level 4; inside Rotary Grocery; across street from Info Booth, and in the Pike Place Grocery and Deli.

**RESTROOMS** one flight of steps down from Market Clock or down ramp at north end by City Fish.

**PDA OFFICE** One level below Pike Place down stairs by Pike Place Fish and Best Flowers.
